During the 2018 the joint venture between the Foundation of the Network for Innovation in Career Guidance and Counselling in Europe (NICE Foundation) and Esvdc continued.

The ESVDC was represented on the NICE Foundation's Board of Directors through an ESVDC Ambassador – currently Hazel Reid (Canterbury Christ Church University and ESVDC Executive Board member).

The ESVDC supported from a scientific point of view the **Academy of the Network for Innovation in Career Guidance and Counselling in Europe (NICE) "Fostering the dialogue between science and practice in career guidance and counselling"**, Jagiellonian University in Krakow, Poland, from September 6<sup>th</sup> to September 8<sup>th</sup> 2018:

ESVDC supported the sixth summer school of the **European Doctoral Programme in Career Guidance and Career Counselling** (Ecadoc project), June 9-14, 2019, addressed to the PhD students from all over the world to stimulate research in the broad area of career guidance and counselling, organized by prof. Ronald Sultana and hosted by EMCER, the research center he leads at the University of Malta.

The ESDVC is playing on an active role in the **16th European Congress of Psychology (ECP2019) “Psychology: Connecting Science to Solutions”**, Moscow, July 2-5 2019:
